Oh, the Places You'll GO!

There are so many great places to go and see in Tehachapi and you may not be aware that there is an equally great way to see them; **Dial-A-Ride!**

For as little as 50¢ to \$1.00, riders can travel within the city limits, Golden Hills or Old Towne just by placing a call.

Here's how it works!

- 1 Plan your trips and then call **Dial-A-Ride at 1-800-323-2396**. (For guaranteed rides, call 1 day in advance.)
- 2 Be sure to have correct change as the drivers don't carry any change.
- 3 Enjoy the ride!

Rides are 75¢ to \$1.00 for General Public and only 50¢ to 75¢ for Seniors, Disabled and Youth (5-15) and Kids under 4 are free with paying adult.

Service is available Monday - Friday from 5:30am to 7:00pm. It's a great way to meet up with friends, take a trip into town or just get around this summer.



TPD Expanding


The Tehachapi Police Department is getting ready for a new facility; something it's needed for quite some time.

Currently located at Robinson and F Street, the TPD has outgrown its 3,920 square foot home and has hence acquired an old manufacturing building on C Street,

just off Curry. This new location will place TPD more centrally in our city and plans have already been drawn, reviewed and awarded so that construction can begin.

Winner of the \$2.8 mil bid was a local firm, Aspen Builders, Inc. who also completed the rebuild of the Depot Museum.

The existing building on C Street (right) will get a new makeover by Aspen Builders including the facade improvements shown below.


Tehachapi Event Center & Rodeo Grounds
