The morning will kick-off with a wonderful **Pancake Breakfast from 7 – 10am hosted by Tehachapi Society of Pilots**. Come and enjoy breakfast in the beautiful Tehachapi Aviator Park and then cheer on runners as Tehachapi Valley Recreation and Parks holds the **Tarmac 5K Run and 1 Mile Kids Fun Run at 8:00 am**.

There has been much media coverage of the Emergency Drought Regulations that have been adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board. To both conserve our precious resource and comply with the regulation, the City of Tehachapi will be implementing these water conservation measures.

Each of the following are prohibited, except where necessary to address an immediate health and safety need or to comply with a term or condition in a permit issued by a state or federal agency.

- » The application of potable water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures;
- » The use of a hose that dispenses potable water to wash a motor vehicle, except where the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle or device attached to it that causes it to cease dispensing water immediately when not in use;

- » The application of potable water to driveways and sidewalks;
- » The use of potable water in a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is part of a recirculating system; and
- » The watering of grass, lawns, groundcover, shrubbery and open ground within any portion of the city between the hours of ten a.m. and four p.m. daily

Infractions are punishable by a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500) for each day in which the violation occurs. These regulations went into effect on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 and last until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015. (Unless extended by the SWRCB).

**1<sup>st</sup> occurrence** – door tag delivered, no penalty

**2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence** – door tag delivered, no penalty

**3<sup>rd</sup> occurrence** – letter from City Code Enforcement, if uncorrected, penalty of up to \$500 may be imposed.
