The City of Tehachapi recently submitted a grant application for funding to make improvements along the railroad corridor through downtown Tehachapi. These improvements will include fencing, sidewalks, landscaping, and improved pedestrian crossings of the railroad tracks along Tehachapi Blvd. We received word that we were recommended for funding which will be taken before the California Transportation Committee in Mid-October, with a goal to begin construction in 2018.

Over 1,000 cyclists registered for the 2nd Annual Tehachapi GranFondo providing incredible donations to many volunteer and non-profit groups that serve our community.



