Building Department

New home construction in Tehachapi is underway and the first three permits on Mulberry have been approved. Three home builders are active in the City as this time: Jed Francis, Tarina Homes, and Forza Construction offering homes of all sizes and types from the starter home for the young family to the generously appointed retirement home.



Improving Infrastructure

Steady work is underway on the Tehachapi Blvd. Improvements Project set to be completed in Winter of this year. The project will boast new sidewalk, street lights, and street trees on Tehachapi Blvd. from Synder Avenue to Dennison Road. Work will also include the widening of the intersection of Tehachapi Blvd. and Dennison Road.



Entry Monument Under Construction

Construction has begun on a new grand entrance to the growing facility off Dennison Road. The entrance boasts attractive access for both vehicles and pedestrians and represents one more step in the journey towards a multi-function events center.
