A Call for VOLUNTEERS



The City of Tehachapi recently submitted a grant application for funding to make improvements along the railroad corridor through downtown Tehachapi. These improvements will include fencing, sidewalks, landscaping, and improved pedestrian crossings of the railroad tracks along Tehachapi Blvd. We have now received word that we will be recommended for funding and while it still needs final approval, it looks like we will be able to make a great safety and beautification improvement soon.

Over 1,000 cyclists registered for the 2nd Annual Tehachapi GranFondo providing incredible donations to many volunteer and non-profit groups that serve our community.


